# Empowered Decision Making 37 Door Sets which transformed the appearance of the communal entrance

## The Client

HBS Steel Doors Ltd received an invitation to tender for a project from a housing association in the North of England for 37 Door sets.

## The Challenge

Prior to the finalised specification being issued to HBS Steel Doors, we were given a particular task to propose a colour scheme which would enable the elderly, and in particular the partially sighted, to better distinguish and locate the door handles against the background colour of the doors.

### The Solution

Through displaying various colour schemes of door background colours and door handle colours, a consensus of opinion was formed and duly finalised by the residents themselves

### The Results
